Assembly Event Summary

Our Course takes us through the sorrows of the loss of our Beloved Brother Knight Phil Gasior. The communal ROSARY the night before, and then the REQUIEM MASS with Sir Knights in Uniform and those in Baldric, in attendance, were testaments of how much he meant to us all. The Assembly Meeting IAW our By Laws, passed a formal "RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE" that will be presented in a leatherette embossed folder to his family at an appropriate time. Three Masses at St Lawrence (October 8th: 8 AM/October 24th: 9 AM/ All Souls November 2nd: 9 AM) will beseech the Holy Trinity to welcome our brother to eternal life.

One point in the distance of our course (December 16th) will likely be participation in WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA honoring Veterans. In my view, the CANTON National Cemetery has become greatly overloaded and difficult, and approaching 20,000 participants. While that is amazing, right here in Lawrenceville, East Shadowlawn Memorial Gardens is encouraging and will welcome our support and participation to assist with their annual Wreaths for those Veterans interred in our own backyard. If the Assembly wishes to do that, we will be reaching out to those Councils wishing to join the effort. Each Council joining the effort can add WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA to its Community Program category. Donations for wreaths are NOT required (if that is not currently in that council's budget) but welcome. Our KNIGHTS' labor participation (and that of any wives and children wishing to participate) for a couple hours would be a collective event, and maybe even some local BBQ for a noon meal of fellowship afterwards. I will be reaching out to Councils 13052, 13440, 13450 (at St Alphonsa), 13229 (St Matthews) with invitations and coordinating information when the Assembly approves our course.




Athens Pregnancy Center Ultrasound Dedication
